Dear Parents/Caregivers,

As we approach the last day of school tomorrow, we wanted to take the opportunity to let you know how much we appreciate your support during these unprecedented times. Thank you for working diligently to facilitate the distance learning process with your student(s) remotely in your home in addition to work schedules and other important responsibilities.

Please know the administrative team has been working with the health department and following the Governor's guidelines to create a plan for safe return to the new school year on August 24, 2020. The safety of our students and staff is our number one priority. We will keep you updated via email and calls through the One Call System in the weeks ahead on our restart plan.

I also wanted to let you know we will be completing some improvements to all three locations with the hopes to have the work completed before the start of the new school year. Through the support of the Hine Memorial Fund we will be working on the following projects:

High School:

- Relocating the front office to the rear of the building. This will make the front desk easily accessible for parents and visitors.
- Upgrades to security cameras, PA system, and security button at front desk and closing in the landings.

Elementary/Middle School:

- Motorizing the gate openings with a button to ring the front desk for entry into the back parking lot.
- Additional security cameras, a security button and closing in the landings are planned.

Preschool:

- Upgrading the current security system and securing the playground.
- Installing a building wide PA system.

All three locations will be transitioned to LED lighting. This will soften the lighting within the building and classrooms as well as being more efficient on energy.
