On October 3, 1953, the founding trustees, Mrs. Norman Auburn, Dale Brothers and John H. Yerian signed the original Articles of Incorporation and hired Christine Kline as the very first Executive Director. The agency was originally founded as the United Cerebral Palsy Association.

In 1975, Ms. Kline led the reincorporation of the Potential Development Program. Potential Development has always been a special needs preschool, in the beginning serving children with orthopedic and medical issues. The change in 1975 probably started the drive toward serving students with autism even though it was not a formal diagnosis at the time. That started in the 1990's and continues today.

The beginning of the school age program in 2001 was a huge change for Potential Development and really took us from a small nonprofit to a full-blown comprehensive school system for students with autism spectrum disorder.

The street fairs and carnivals of the 1950's have become the Mahoning Valley Pizza Cook-off and Trivia with a Twist.

The evolution of Potential Development has been an amazing journey!!!
